2020 Summer Camps

In order to guarantee compliance with all rules and norms regarding health and social distance, this year's weekly capacity is reduced below 50%. Thus, the only available programme is the 'Sam's Club' with a weekly capacity of 30 participants.

The program will run, as usual, from Monday to Friday, between July 6 and September 4, 2020.

We therefore draw the attention of all participant's parents and legal guardians to the following standards:



1. Registration:

- all registrations are made through our online ticket office - www.zoomarine.pt/en/tickets/
- registrations are only valid after the legal documents (registration and GDPR) are signed and sent to the e-mail: atl@zoomarine.pt at least 5 days before the beginning of the booked programme;



2. Reception of participants:

- the reception area (next to the ticket office) allows the creation of groups of 10 participants, 5 meters apart, in pre-selected areas;
- each group of 10 participants will be received and accompanied to the summer camp building by two educators;
- we recommend all participants and legal guardians to wear social mask;
- to avoid crowding, participants need to wait to be called by name;
- there will be no visit to the physical space of the rooms on the first day of the program (Monday).



3. Organization of each group:

- groups of 10 participants will be organized in order of registration;
- specific requests to change group, for family reasons or affinity, need to be highlighted in the registration process. Decision of change is defined by the organization.



4. Use of the summer camp building:

- each classroom has a maximum capacity of 10 participants. All classrooms have a disinfectant gel dispenser for everyone's daily use;
- each participant have an individual table. All tables are spaced 1.5 meters apart;
- we recommend, for children under 10 years old, the use of social mask inside the classroom and whenever possible;
- all rooms and individual instruments are disinfected at the end of each day.



5. Meals:

- meals (lunches and snacks) take place in a reserved restaurant area and 5 meters apart from other visitors' common areas;
- meals are served independently for each group of 10 participants;
- at lunch, participants are seated alternately respecting a minimum distance of 1.5 meters.



6. Use of Dolphin Emotions, pools and attractions:

- all activities that share areas with other visitors will comply with the park's general health and safety rules;
- the weekly capacity of the Dolphin Emotions experience is limited to 16 participants with the first come, first served rule..



7. Weekly photographs:

- photographs will not be taken during the week, to ensure social distance.



8. Delivery of participants at the end of the day:

- the delivery of the participants at the end of the day takes place at the same place as the beginning of the day;
- the delivery time of the participants is scheduled, daily, between **5:45 pm and 6:00 pm**;
- similar to the beginning of the day, and to avoid crowds, participants will be delivered individually and with a nominal call;
- legal guardians must wait outside the park for individual delivery of participants.



Mandatory personal items for participants:

- Beach towel;
- Sunscreen;
- Flask or similar.

optional for participants between 6 and 9 years old:

- Personal protection kit (community mask, disinfectant);
