

How to become an Official Spark.me 2020 Blogger

The organizing team of [Spark.me](https://spark.me), one of the most carefully curated business/Internet conferences in Southeast Europe, which is set for May 30-31, in [Porto Montenegro](https://www.portomontenegro.com) Auditorium, in Tivat, Montenegro, has published a call for the Official Spark.me 2020 Bloggers. Interested bloggers are not limited to a text-only format – they are free to use audio and video submissions as well, in form of a podcast or a vlog (video blog).

In order to apply, potential bloggers, vloggers, or podcasters are required to write a blog post, record a video, or record a podcast on the topic of “Why I want to attend Spark.me 2020?”, share it on social media with the hashtag #SparkMe, tag the official Spark.me account, and fill in the application form at <http://spark.me/ambassadors/>. Submission deadline is March 29, 23:59:59 UTC. The list of Official Spark.me Bloggers will be published on the conference website on April 15.

The Official Spark.me 2020 Bloggers will be entitled to: a free ticket for both days of Spark.me 2020 (including pass to all conference sessions); four-night accommodation in a single room in the four-star hotel “Magnolia” in Tivat; Bay of Kotor cruise reserved for Spark.me speakers, partners, and organisers; and the recognition on the conference website and social media outlets as an Official Spark.me 2020 Blogger. The Official Spark.me 2020 Bloggers are expected to publish one Spark.me related pieces of content (a blog post, a video, or a podcast) before May 15, actively report on social media channels during the conference, publish one piece of content after the conference (before June 5), and publish one piece of content in the week following the Super Early Bird ticket sale announcement for the Spark.me 2020.
