Description:

“Feel the pulse of the city from the heart of the bushveld.” River Crossing is 5 km from Windhoek, situated on the airport road and only 5 minutes from the heart of Windhoek. The lodge is situated on top of a koppie on a pristine 6500 hectare reserve, offering unparalleled sunset views. River Crossing will allow you to rediscover the nuances of a bygone era of farm life and offers the discerning traveller all the modern comforts.

The main lodge building comprises a dining room, a centrally situated bar, a lounge with fireplace, and curio corner. Nestled outside between the lounge and dining area is the lap pool and elevated wooden deck that stretches out under the sun. At centre stage, in full view of the main deck stand the Moltkeblick Mountain in contrast to the blanket of flickering city lights of Windhoek.

Guests are welcome to enjoy the spectacular view while dining outside or enjoying cocktails any time of the day. The Lodge together with its rooms have been designed to emulate old German farm houses each with a small “stoep” and “afdakkie” overlooking the natural surroundings.

River Crossing is also the perfect venue for conferences and functions. The conference room can seat up to 65 delegates and the lodge is geared to cater for almost any kind of event or function including birthday bashes, weddings, wedding anniversaries and many more.

Accommodation Configuration:

The **20 guest chalets** consist of **14 twin chalets** and **6 double chalets** (all chalets have en suite bathrooms with showers, loos and basins). Two of the chalets have been designed with honeymooners in mind and have baths instead of showers ...of course all rooms have the feather duvets wrapped in 100% cotton, the environmentally friendly guest amenities and the unparalleled service and hospitality to consider too.

6 chalets offer views of Windhoek and 14 face east offering superb sunrise views of the Moltkeblick Mountain.



Families with Children:

All age groups are welcome at the lodge. Children may also participate on activities while under a parent supervision.

- Conferencing facilities include a boardroom large enough for 65 delegates with WiFi access, flip chart and digital projector
- Transfers can be arranged to most points of interest in town including Windhoek and Eros airport

Activities:

The game drives morning and afternoon are engaging with superb views, varied flora and abundant game. Nineteen different species roam the reserve, including roan, sable, giraffe and wildebeest, leopard and cheetah are also seen from time to time.

The reserve can also be explored on foot while accompanied by one of our guides or on your own. Existing roads and game tracks make the going easier on foot. The reserve is very hilly, so a basic level of fitness is required.

Mountain bike enthusiasts are welcome to bring their own bikes to self-explore the terrain and its challenges. Horses are also a very eco-friendly way of exploring the lie of the land... quiet and un-invasive allowing guests to get a lot closer to the game than in a vehicle.

If the bush does not interest you then, there is Windhoek City with its many malls, shops and markets where you can shop till you drop!
