



Introduction:

Just 20 kilometres east of Windhoek lies Moonraker Outdoor Adventure Camp — a welcoming and down-to-earth adventure camp nestled in the heart of the African bush. Ideally located between Hosea Kutako International Airport and Windhoek's city centre, this peaceful hideaway sits at the base of the picturesque Auas Mountain Range.

Spanning 2,000 hectares within the historic Finkenstein Farm, the area has been designated a private nature reserve, created to showcase the region's natural splendour and rich biodiversity. In 2018, two families — the Goldbecks and the Finkes — joined forces, combining their visions and resources to bring Moonraker to life: a place where people, wildlife, and the environment thrive together in harmony.

A favourite feature among visitors is the quaint farmyard, home to a lively collection of domestic animals, perfect for an authentic farm experience. Guided by a deep respect for the environment, the camp promotes sustainable living and a close connection to nature.

Upon arrival at the remote mountain camp, you'll settle into a tranquil setting far from the buzz of modern life. Here, you'll have the choice of sleeping comfortably in a tent nestled among the trees or, for those craving a more adventurous experience, on a stretcher bed under the open sky. There's nothing quite like drifting off to sleep with only the stars above and the sounds of nature around you.

Evenings at the camp are a special experience. After a satisfying, freshly prepared meal made with care by our team, guests gather around the campfire to share stories, sip warm drinks, and soak in the peaceful ambiance. The quiet majesty of the mountains at night, combined with the warmth of the campfire, makes for a truly magical end to the day.

How to reach us:

Approximately 15m before the roadblock on the B1 going to the Hosea Kutako International Airport the turn-off to Moonraker is on your right hand side. Cross over the railway tracks and enter the gate with the Moonraker sign on. Continue on the road following the signs until you reach another gate at the new highway. Go through the gate and cross the double highway. On the other side you will enter another gate with the Moonraker sign on. Continue on this road for approximately another 3km before you reach the lodge.
