



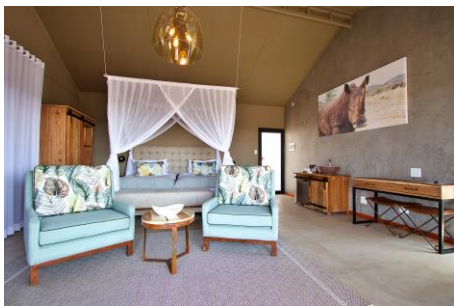
Kifaru Luxury Lodge & Bush Camp

Introduction

For an exclusive tented safari experience, look no further than Kifaru Luxury Tented Lodge & Camp. This exclusive paradise offers guests the opportunity to engage in the tranquillity of the Namibian Bushveld. Guests can indulge in the picturesque Namibian sunsets while enjoying the atmosphere of peace and seclusion.

Kifaru Luxury Lodge and Bush Camp stands proudly upon the beautifully weathered peaks of the surrounding landscape. There is an abundant ecosystem boasting more than 60 species of mammals and over 300 bird species that can be spotted on the reserve. Kifaru offers so much more than beautiful accommodation and attentive service; we are also proudly affiliated with the Rhino Momma Project. The name 'Kifaru' means 'Rhino' in Swahili, and the conservation of these critically endangered animals is at the heart of the Kifaru ethos, with the majority of the revenue generated by the lodge going directly towards Rhino Momma and their conservation efforts.

Early mornings will reward you with a breathtaking sunrise accompanied by a cup of coffee to prepare you for a morning game drive or tracking walk. If you feel like relaxing, the lodge is the perfect place for alternative activities such as birding or relaxing at the poolside with a cocktail from the bar.

The Tents are perched in the hillside of the reserve, offering the best views of the landscape below. All rooms are airconditioned with en-suite bathrooms, mosquito nets and viewing decks.

4 Premier Tented Chalets are air-conditioned with en-suite bathrooms, each with their own indoor and outdoor shower, toilet & free-standing bath and private deck as well as a safe, minibar, coffee station and bathroom amenities.

2 Deluxe Tented Chalets are air-conditioned with en-suite bathrooms. Each room has a private deck as well as a safe, minibar, coffee station and bathroom amenities.

Bush Camp

Guests looking for a more easy-going, adventurous experience can enjoy the rustic **Bush Camp** situated 5 km from the Main Luxury Lodge. The main area of the Bush Camp is double volume and has been built to resemble a barn, allowing for a light and airy feeling and free flow throughout the building. The large, farm-style wrap-around verandas overlooking beautiful nature like only Namibia can boast, and a swimming pool which has been built to resemble a traditional Namibian farm dam. This allows guests the possibility of enjoying a nightcap and game viewing without necessarily even leaving the comfort of the sofa!

12 Double / Twin Rooms

This camp consists of **12 cosy double / twin rooms**, each with en-suite bathrooms consisting of a shower and a toilet. Bush Camp is ideal for smaller groups and families travelling together on a budget.

How to Get There:

We recommend setting your Tyre Pressure to 1.8 bar in Outjo.

This will contribute to a more comfortable drive to the lodge.

*Please call us before you leave Outjo, so that we can give you the updated gate codes and so that we also know when to expect you. **Do not use google maps** as it will take you on the wrong route, please follow the directions below to make it safely to our remote and beautiful lodge.*

Coming from Windhoek:

Drive the B1 Okahandja, Otjiwarongo (C38) to Outjo route, drive through Outjo on the C38, just outside Outjo **(DO NOT TURN RIGHT IN OUTJO, DRIVE THOROUGH OUTJO AS YOU WOULD DRIVE TO OKAUKEJO, ETOSHA)** turn right on the C39 towards Otavi, after about 1km, take the F3287 (20°05'55.1"S 16°09'11.2"E) gravel road on your left.

Coming from Etosha, Okaukuejo:

Take the C38 to Outjo, turn left on the C39 just before Outjo and after about 1km, take the first gravel road on your left, marked F3287 (20°05'55.1"S 16°09'11.2"E).

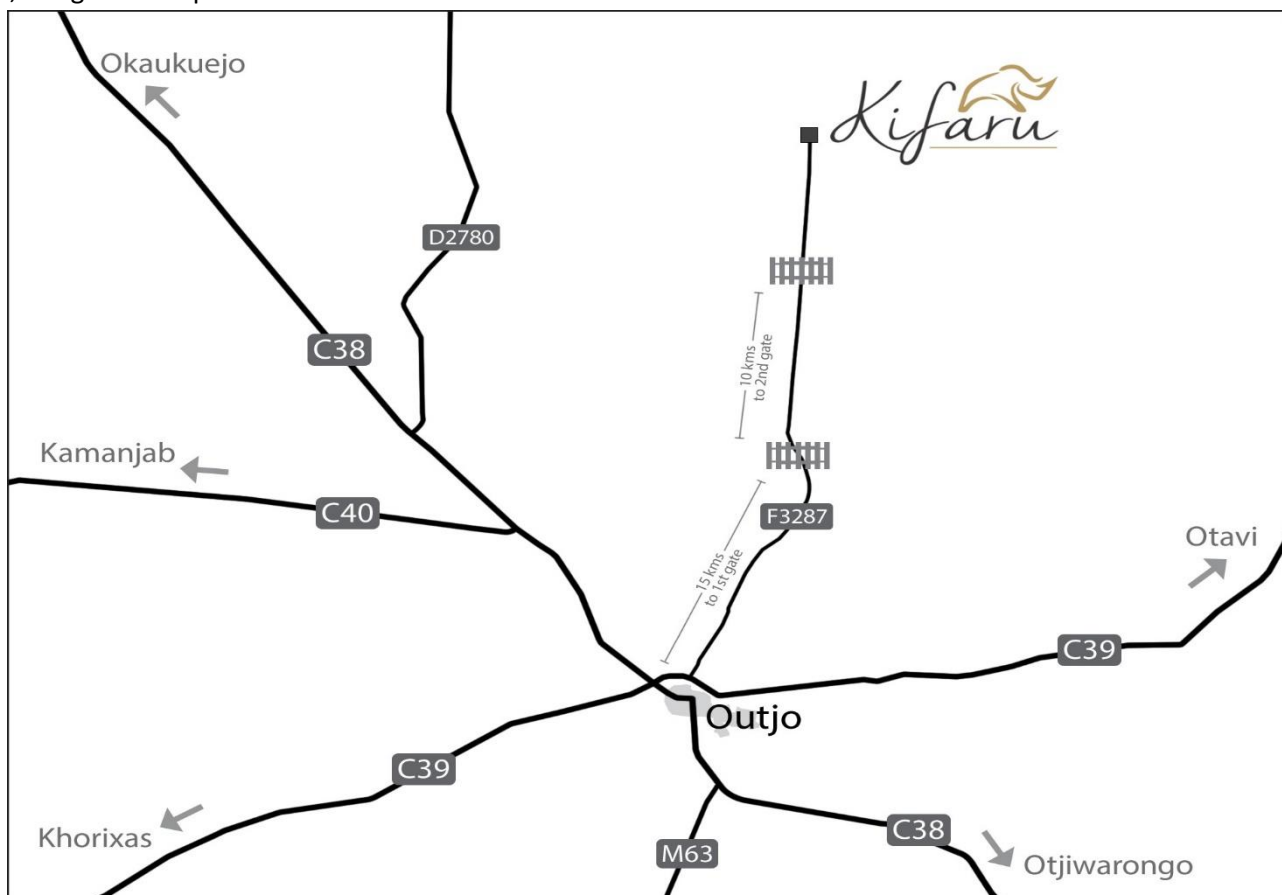
Coming from Swakopmund:

Take the B2, just outside of Karibib, take the C33 to Omaruru & outside of Kalkveld take the M63 (gravel road) to Outjo, drive through Outjo on the C38, just outside Outjo turn right on the C39 towards Otavi, after about 1km, take the first gravel road on your left, marked F3287 (20°05'55.1"S 16°09'11.2"E).

Coming from Otjiwarongo:

Take the C38 to Outjo, drive through Outjo on the C38, just outside Outjo turn right on the C39 towards Otavi, after about 1km, take the first gravel road on your left, marked F3287 (20°05'55.1"S 16°09'11.2"E).

Once on the F3287, stay on this road and follow the direction boards. DO NOT turn left or right on any other road. You will pass over several grid gates, drive until you arrive at a large double gate that is closed, (+-13km out of Outjo) this is the first time you will have to get out and open the gate (The gate codes are changed periodically, as a security measure to help try and curb any poaching attempts, so please do contact us for the correct codes before departing Outjo), please make sure the gate is closed behind you. Follow the road until you get to a house with tall palm trees, (+-25km from Outjo) once you have arrived at Kifaru's main gate please use the keypad and key in the second gate code, the gate will open in a few minutes.
