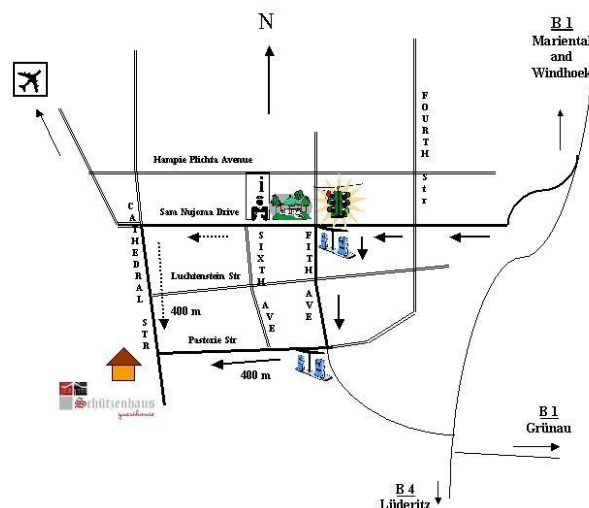

On your journey in southern Namibia, driving south on the B1 from Windhoek you will reach Keetmanshoop after 482km. Coming into town on the Sam Nujoma Drive continue till the Robot intersection (Petrol and Service Station is situated to your left). Turn left in a southerly direction into Fifth Street till you reach the Pastorie Street (3rd road). Turn right into Pastorie Street traveling in a westerly direction. After 400 meters you will reach the Schützenhaus Guesthouse, which is situated across the street.
