

## Peregrine Houseboat

**Peregrine** is a basic but comfortable and spacious pontoon houseboat.

### Facilities include:

- **MAX PAX:** Capacity for 16 passengers comfortably
  - **CREW:** 3 (Captain, Chef & Deckhand)
  - **CRUISING SPEED:** 8 - 9 knots
  - **CABINS:** 6 cabins with 2 beds in each which can convert to double beds
  - **AIR CONDITIONING:** No, but there are fans
  - **BATHROOMS:** 2 bathrooms (shower, toilet, wash basin with gas geyser)
  - **SWIMMING FACILITIES:** Splash Pool on Bermuda deck
  - **KITCHEN:** Fully equipped Galley Fridges are Freezers are run on the Solar.
  - **BAR AREA:** **On top deck. Radio with speakers (usb, aux & blue tooth), please bring your own music, cables & adaptors. There is also a dart board, but please bring your own darts.**
  - **POWER SUPPLY:** 12v lighting powered by solar panels and 220v 5kva generator (run time max 6 hrs.)
  - **PLUG POINTS:** Square, clients must take own adaptors if necessary
  - **SAFE:** There is a combination safe on board for valuables.
  - **CHILD FRIENDLY:** Yes
  - **TENDER BOATS:** 1 x pontoon, powered by a 55hp Evinrude motor and 1 x Sportster powered by a 115hp Yamaha Motor **PLEASE NOTE: Tender Boats are for Game Drives and fishing in the vicinity of the houseboat and are strictly crew driven. Should you require a speed boat for long distance fishing, please either bring your own which will be towed behind the houseboat, leaving behind one of the houseboat tenders, - please bring your own rope and fuel. Or you can hire a speed boat from Marineland. (Contact us for details).**
  - **BRAAI ON BOARD**
  - **BOARDING:** 12:00pm and disembarking 10:00am
  - **MOORED:** Cutty Sark
  - **SAFETY EQUIPMENT:** (ship to shore radio, 2x12 man life rafts, life rings, life jackets, fire ext.)

### Rates Exclude:

- All fuel for main vessel and tender boats
- All meals, drinks, condiments, serviettes, soap and personal toiletries etc.
- Swimming Towels
- Cleaning materials, dishwashing liquid and Toilet Paper
- Fishing equipment and bait
- Ice (recommended 4 blocks per day during winter and 5 blocks per day in the summer months)
- Charcoal / wood, firelighters and matches
- National Parks lake usage and fishing fees

- First aid kit
- Vehicle parking fees
- Crew gratuities
